<p>Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean Observed mops stored on floor near mop sink. Remove and hang on rack above floor. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.</p>
<p>Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting Observed burnt out light bulb in reach in refrigerator. Replace light bulb. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>
